## Recent advances in vertebrate taphonomy

Recent advances in vertebrate taphonomy have been driven by the need to better understand, and quantify, the information loss from death of the animal to final burial and fossilization. This has been greatly enhanced by neutron and synchrotron beam imaging of the unprepared fossils as well as geochemical and isotopic analyses. We would host a symposium of vertebrate taphonomists who are leading this new wave of research.
